Pencil Pusher

One of the industry's last American manufacturers, the family-owned General Pencil Company has been making top-of-the-line pencils, charcoal and pastels in Jersey City, New Jersey, since 1889. Those include their classic cedar-wood-and-graphite Draughting Pencil, a favorite of architects, which retains its tip shape longer than almost any other instrument of its kind.
